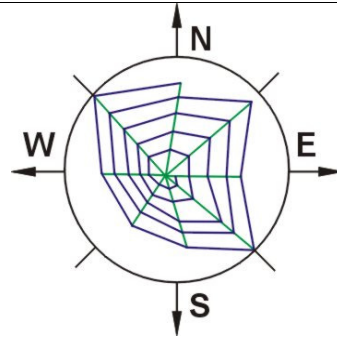

Goals and scope

The aim of this year's workshop is to create a forum for discussion and development of scientific potential concerning indoor air quality, chemical and biological pollutants levels, mechanisms of pollutant formation, migration from sources to indoor air, and mitigation processes, by which pollutant emissions to the environment may be reduced (including HVAC systems and low emission materials).

2. Thermal comfort and energy savings
3. Biological and chemical pollutants in indoor air
4. New emerging pollutants in indoor air
5. Impact on indoor air quality on health and work efficiency.
6. Mitigation strategies
7. Other – depends on paper submission
